1st Gateway Credit Union will be awarding three \$1000 scholarships to high school seniors who are members of the credit union. To be eligible, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a member of 1st Gateway Credit Union
- Submit a copy of your high school transcripts with your application
- Submit a 200-400 word essay on the following topic:

"What does your f nancial plan/budget look like as you are preparing for college? How do you plan to manage your college debt post-graduation?
